The Checklist

Undiscounted Outs

Undiscounted Draw	Outs on the Flop	Odds on the Turn
Backdoor straight draw	1.5	31.5:1
Backdoor flush draw	2	22.5:1
Gutshot	4	7:1
Draw to two pair & trips	5	8:1
Overcards	6	7:1
Open-ended straight draw	8	5:1
Flush draw	9	4:1

1 Card backdoor flush draw

2-Cards Backdoor flush draw is not discounted.

	3+ Opponents	< 3 Opponents
A	2	2
K	1.5	1.5
Q	0.25	1
9+	0	0.75
< 9	0	0.5

Backdoor straight draw

BDSD	Number of Outs	
	Rainbow Board	2-suited Board
0-Gap-BDSD	1,5	1
1-Gap-BDSD	0.75	0.5
2-Gap-BDSD	0.25	0

Open-ended Straight draw

Two opponents: Discount tainted outs by half

More than two opponents: Discount tainted outs completely

	2-suited Board	9:1	10.5:1
1-Card-Gutshot on ...	Rainbow Board	10:1	10.5:1
	2-suited Board	14:1	14:1



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
