Example: You are sitting in MP2. You are holding Ace Queen suited (AQs). The chart entry (A8s) in the MP2-column tells you that you should raise hands containing an Ace, and at least an eight as kicker. Worse hands you should fold. Therefore you raise.

3-Bet against a raise from these positions including small blind defence

Example: There is a raise from the MP2 position. You are holding Ace Queen suited (AQs). The chart entry (AJs) in the MP2 column tells you, you should raise again with AJs or better. Therefore you raise.

Against a 3-Bet you cap with these Hands

Example: There is a raise and a call in front of you, it doesn't matter in which order. You are holding JT. Since the raiser is not counted you look into column "1". The entry say "T9s/-". You therefore call.

Example: You are sitting in the big blind with King Queen offsuit (KQo). A player raises from the button, all other players folded. Because the raise is from the button you look into the "BU" column. The entry there is "K7o/KQo", which tells you to call with K7o or better and to raise with KQo or better. You therefore raise.

Example: You are sitting in the small blind and hold 76s with one caller in front of you. You should call here since the chart entry states that "54s" or better is needed to call.

Example: You are holding KJo after two callers. You should only call because the chart entry states "KTo/KQo". This means you need at least KQo or better to raise here.

Important: Hands, that should be raised according to this chart, also need to be listed in the first-in chart for you to raise them. Otherwise you should fold.



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
