JJ, TT	No	Call	Raise

99 to 22	No	Call

AQ, AJ, KQ	No	Fold		Raise

Aces: AJ
Kings: KQ
Pairs: all pairs from 99 to 66



You are on the Button



Aces: AJ, AT
Kings: KQ, KJ, KT
Queens: QJ
Pairs: all pairs from 99 to 22



You are in the Small Blind



Aces: AJ, AT, A9, A8
Kings: KQ, KJ, KT, K9
Queens: QJ, QT
Pairs: all pairs from 99 to 22

Your opponent raised in early position



Aces: AK, AQ

Pairs: AA, KK, QQ

Pairs: all pairs from AA to 77



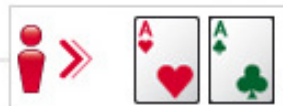

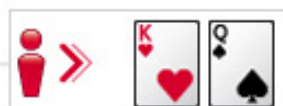
